Special Curriculum Features:

Dutchtown High School offers a full variety of Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) classes.

For AP courses, Cohort of 2021/2022 will have ten (10) numerical points added to the final grade. Cohort of 2023/2024 will have one (1) quality point added to the GPA. These additional points are added by Henry County Schools only. These points are NOT used in the calculation of the HOPE scholarship and are NOT used by many colleges. Colleges/universities, and the Georgia Student Finance Commission (HOPE) add their own uniform point values for Advanced Placement courses

For Honors courses, Cohort of 2021/2022 will have five (5) numerical points added to the final grade. Cohort of 2023/2024 will have a half (.5) quality point added to the GPA. These additional points are added by Henry County Schools only. These points are NOT used in the calculation of the HOPE scholarship and are NOT used by many colleges.

Honors classes are available for 9th Grade Literature, World Literature, American Literature and British Literature; Algebra I, Geometry, and Advanced Algebra; Biology and Chemistry; American Government, World History, US History and Economics; Spanish II, III and IV; French III and IV.

AP classes are available for Language, Literature, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, World History, US History, American Government, Macroeconomics, Spanish, Psychology, and Studio Art.

Dual Enrollment: Students have the option to enroll in a college to earn both high school and college credit. This program for the state of Georgia is called the Dual Enrollment and is reflected on a student's transcript with DE (Dual Enrollment) as the course title. Students enrolling in colleges and universities will need to present a college transcript along with their high school transcript for enrollment.
